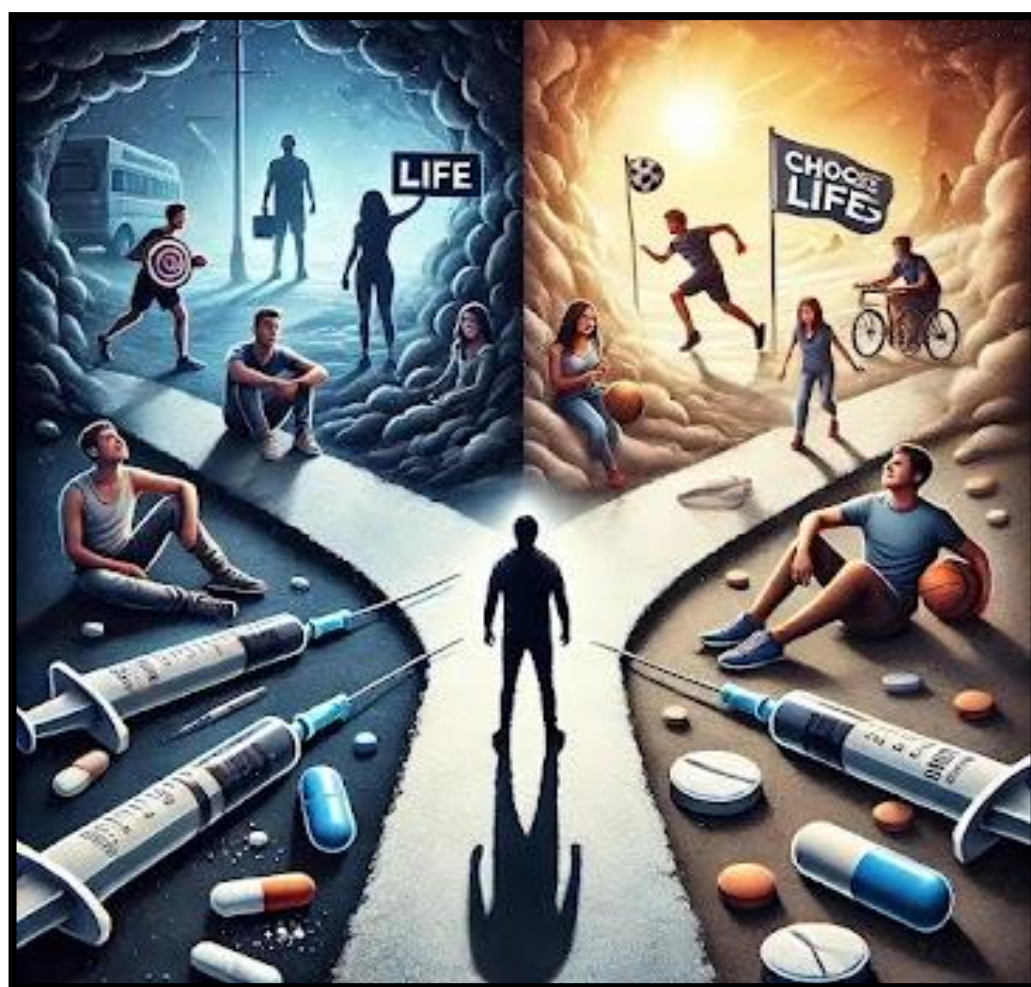
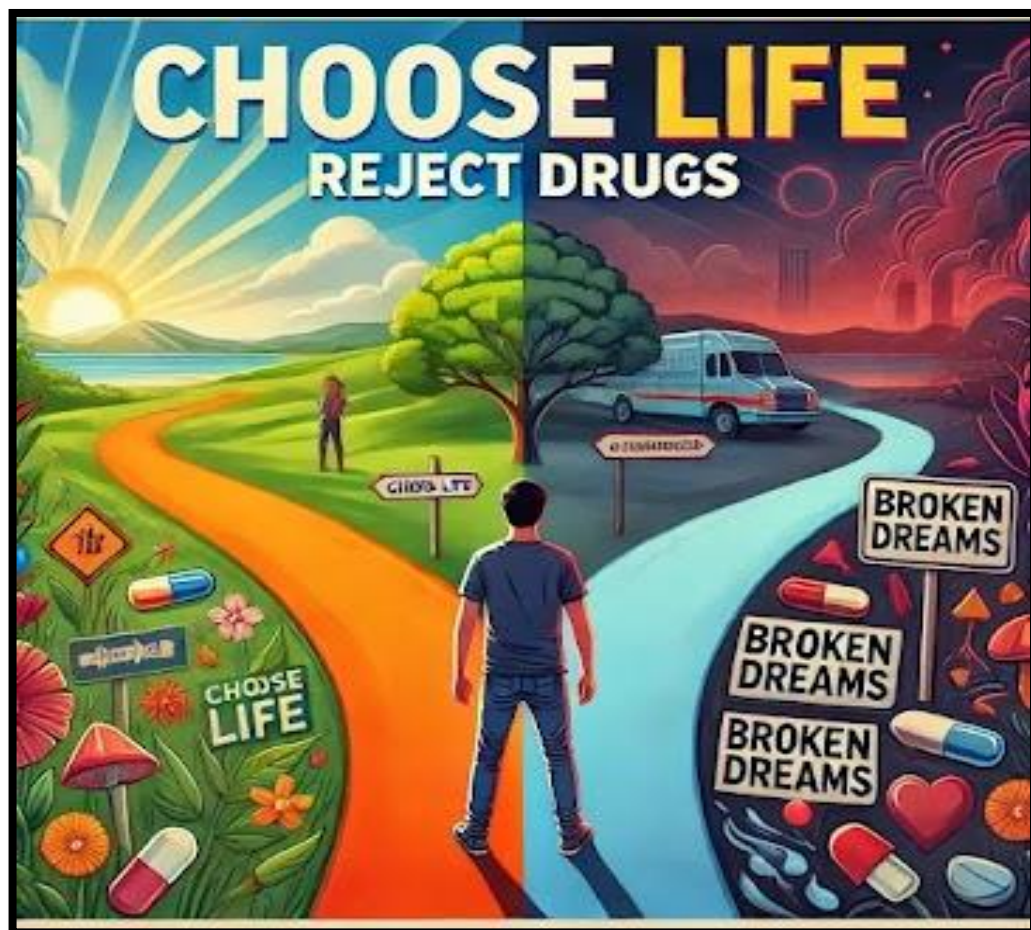

Rationale:

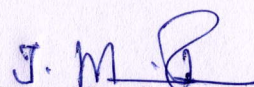
- To create awareness about the harmful effects of drugs.

- To strengthen the anti-drug message within the academic community.

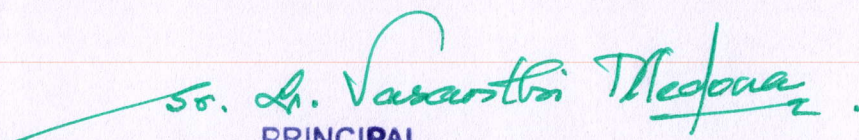
Minutes:
