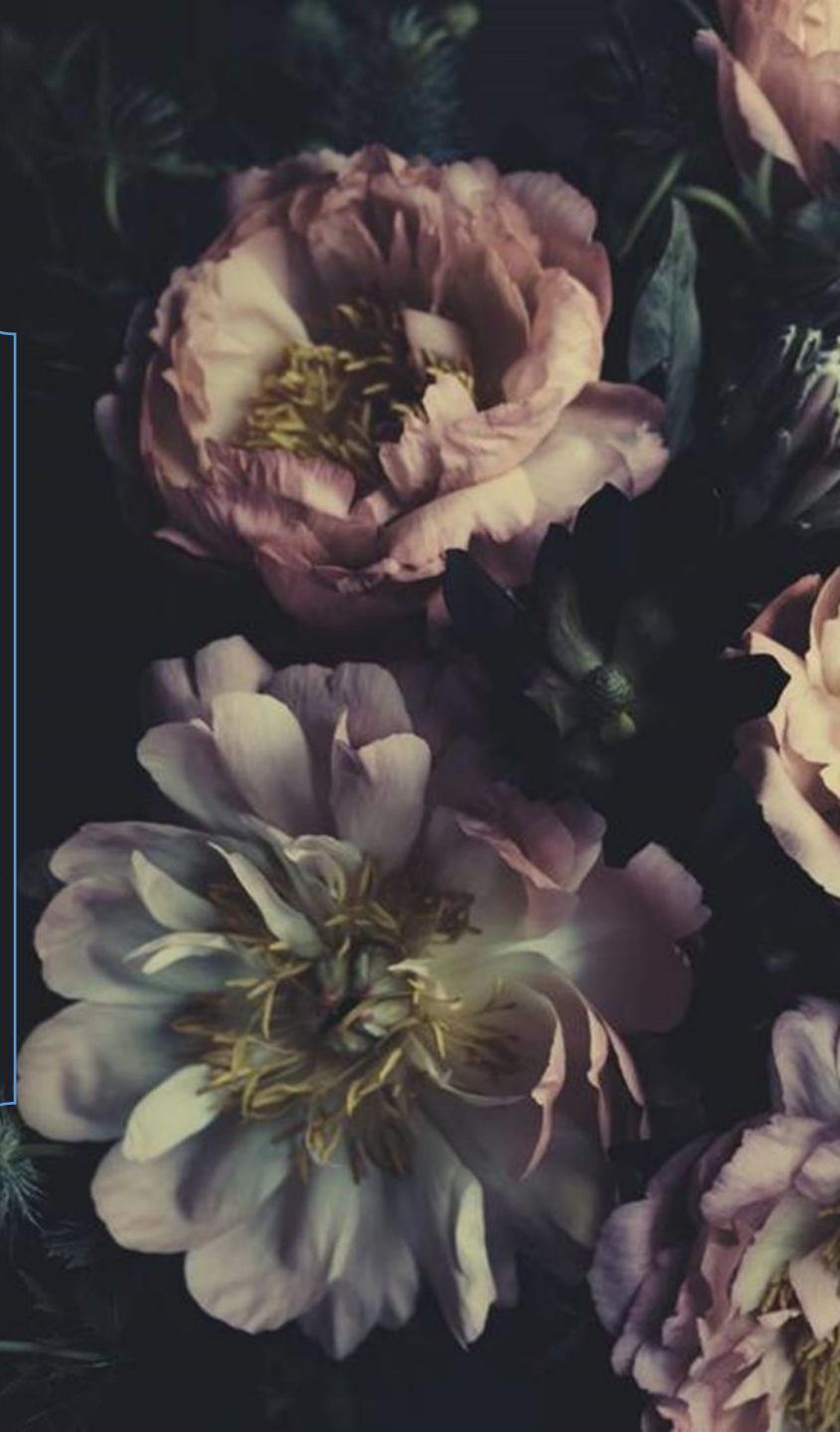


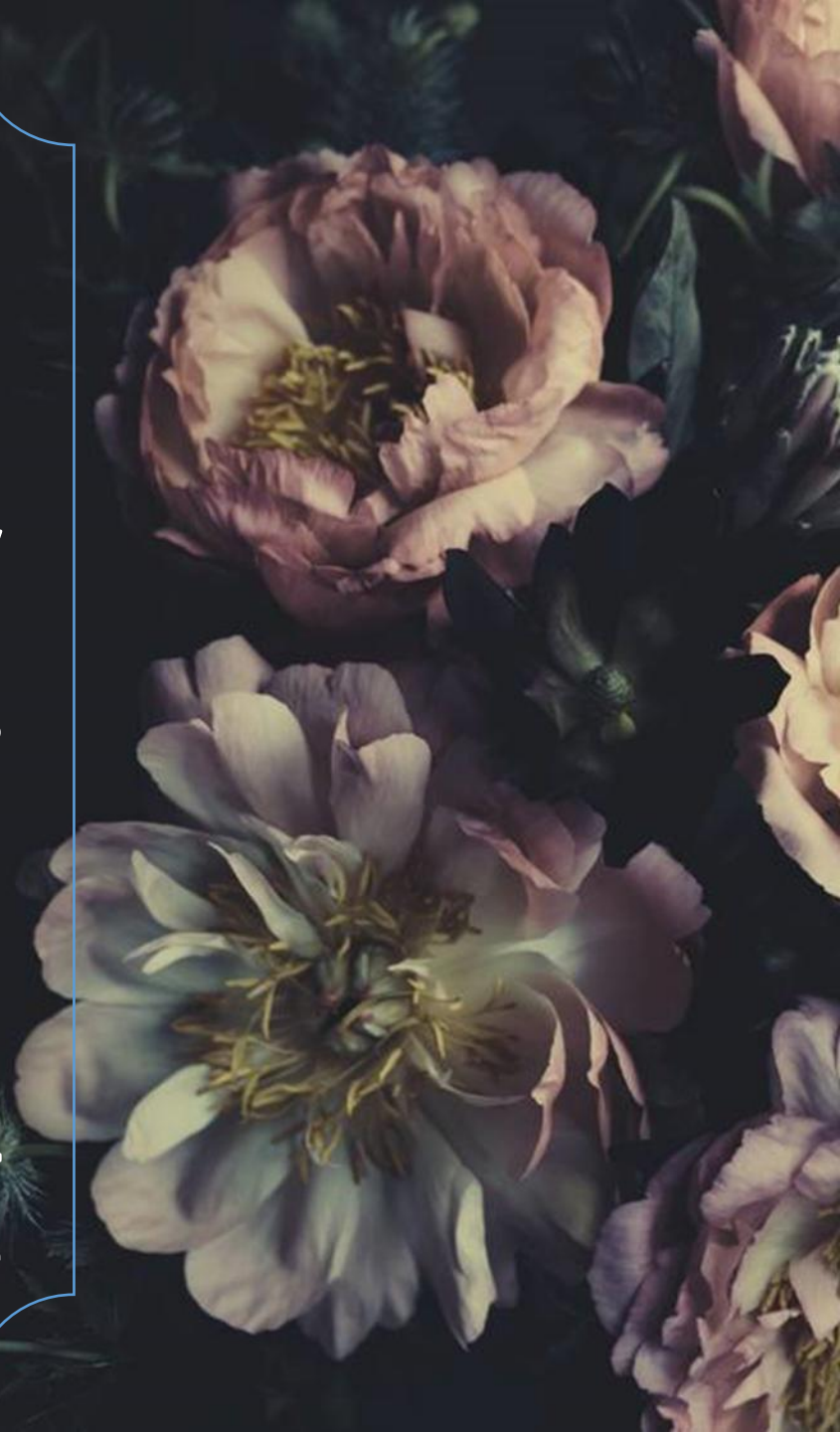

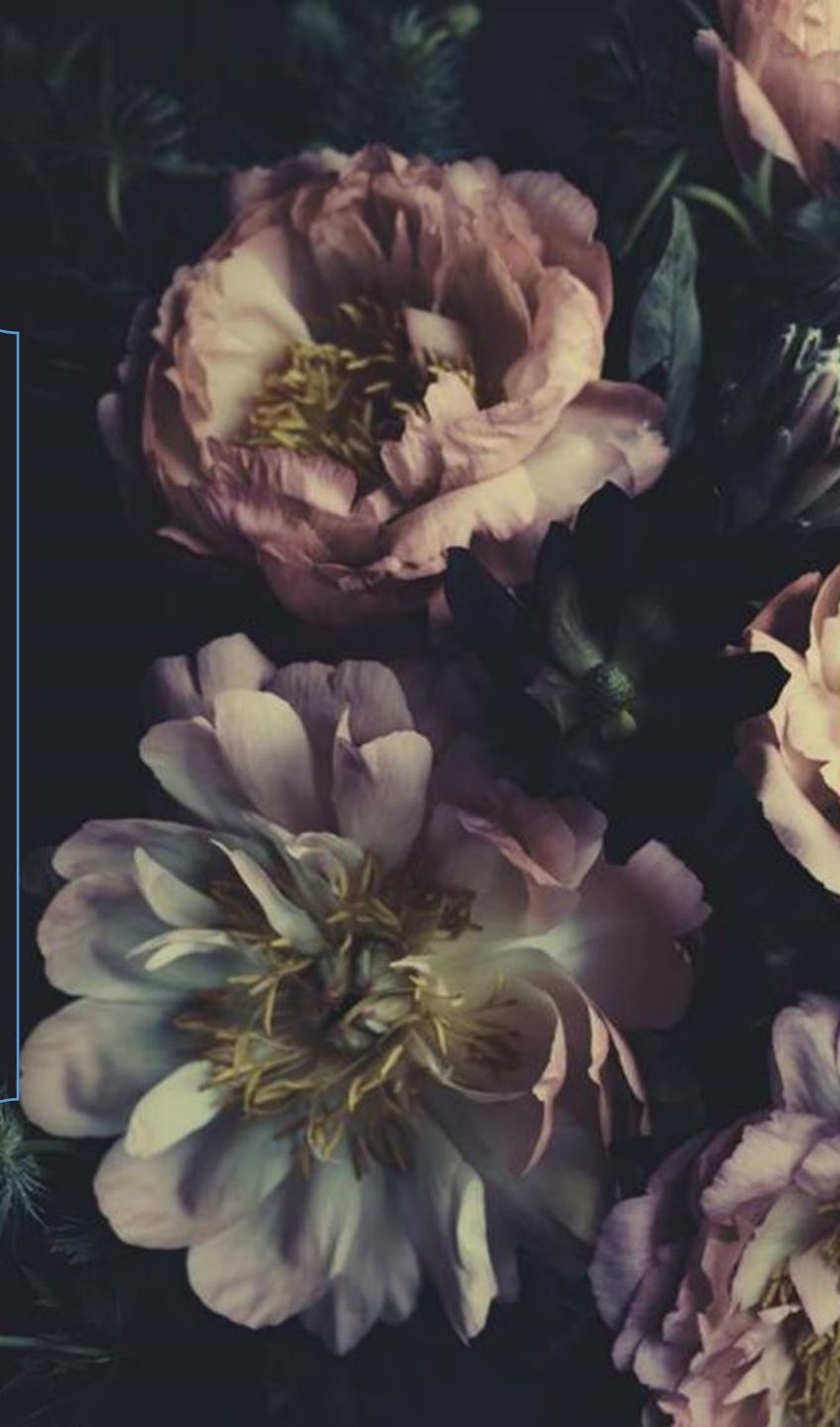


About the Village: Maruthur

- **Maruthur is a Village in Palayamkottai Block in Tirunelveli District of Tamil Nadu.**
- **The village is surrounded by wetlands and paddy fields.**
- **The main occupation of the population is agriculture and cattle rearing. In the summer, pulses are grown as a relay crop.**
- **There are three tanks to irrigate the paddy crop, and the Palayam channel of Thamirabharani irrigation system acts as a feeding channel for the tanks. Thamirabharani river flows on the eastern side of the village.**
