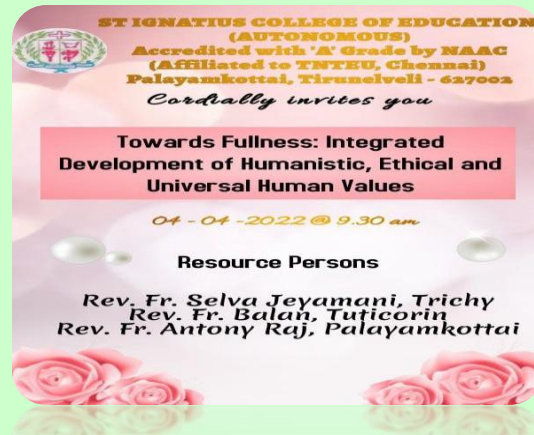
CONSTITUTION AND WOMEN'S RIGHTS
