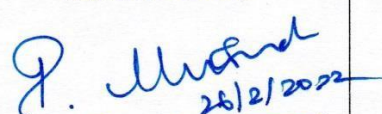
After validation of the records, the committee observes the following:

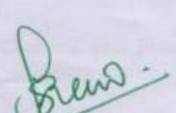

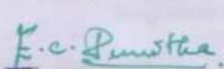

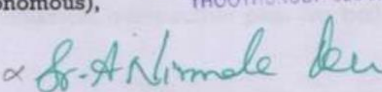
