

ADMISSION COMMITTEE

Admission is based on the policy of the Congregation and the rules and norms of the State Government and NCTE. 50 out of the 200 seats available for B.Ed. level will be filled in by the Government through counseling process. The remaining 150 seat (100 self finance, 50 management) will be filled-in by the management. In this management quota, preference is given to the following weaker section of society.

Preference in Admission:

1. First generation learners.
2. Socially and economically deprived students.
3. Minorities, Marginalized and deprived sectors.
4. Around 10% seats are allotted for SC students every year.
5. Due preference is given for candidates in and around our locality(Tvl.)
6. The Principle of secularism is followed by the selection committee by admitting worthy students irrespective of caste and creed.
